



GROUP COUNSELING FACILITATOR

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

The Group Counseling Facilitator will:

- ❑ Facilitate weekly counseling groups for male identifying survivors of sexual violence at STAR's New Orleans office
- ❑ Complete intake assessments with new clients to screen for readiness for group
- ❑ Ensure case documentation is up-to-date and reflective of services provided
- ❑ Participate in weekly meetings with the Greater New Orleans Counseling Director
- ❑ Participate in counseling team meetings every other week with Greater New Orleans Counseling Team
- ❑ Assist in developing reports as required by funder(s)
- ❑ Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor

QUALIFICATIONS

- ❑ Candidate must be a licensed social worker or counselor in the State of Louisiana and have a minimum of a Master's Degree in one or more of the following: mental health counseling, marriage and family therapy, social work or related field.
- ❑ Candidate must provide a copy of their license, proof of liability insurance and must be able to demonstrate relevant experience and training.
- ❑ Candidate must be knowledgeable of the principles of therapeutic practices and theories related to working with survivors of sexual trauma, including working with the continuum of sexual violence.
- ❑ Candidate must be knowledgeable of the intertextualities of sexual violence, with gender identity, gender expression, race, addiction and toxic masculinity.
- ❑ Candidate must consent to and successfully complete a full background investigation, which includes a criminal history check and finger printing.
- ❑ Candidate must be able to work independently with limited supervision.
- ❑ Candidate must be able to identify and respond to shifting priorities.
- ❑ Candidate must have the ability to handle multiple tasks simultaneously and have excellent organizational skills.
- ❑ Candidate must have mastery of the following:
 - Strong oral communication skills required to effectively communicate with a broad range of individuals
 - Strong written communications skills required to maintain quality documentation
 - Professionalism with clients and co-workers
 - Ethical behavior and respect for confidentiality

TERM AND COMPENSATION

The term of this position will begin August 1, 2019, and will conclude on June 31, 2020, with the option for contract renewal dependent on funding availability. The Group Counseling Facilitator will be compensated \$75 per hour for a weekly hourly total not to exceed 4 hours per week.
