Description: This bill would allow people to donate a portion of their state income tax return to Sexual Trauma Awareness and Response (STAR) organization.

Description: This bill would allow sexual assault to be included as a reason for early lease termination.

Description: This bill allows survivors to apply for protection orders by written affirmation rather than an affidavit, which requires a notary.

Description: This bill would implement mandatory reporting of sexual misconduct on college campuses, but it would also reduce TOPs payments as a penalty.

Description: This bill would revise and provide consistent definitions of domestic abuse in Louisiana law.

Description: This bill appoints a member of STAR to the Louisiana Sexual Assault Oversight Commission.



HB 542

Description: This bill would ban trans students from playing sports on the team that matches their gender in K-12 and post-secondary schools.



SB 156

Description: This bill would ban trans students from playing sports on the team that matches their gender in K-12 and post-secondary schools.



HB 564

Description: This bill would prohibit teaching concepts related to racism and sexism in elementary and secondary schools and postsecondary education institutions.



SB 211

Description: This bill would require in-service training for teachers and certain other school personnel on adverse childhood experiences and trauma-informed education.



HB 575

Committee: House Health & Welfare
Description: This bill would ban clinically appropriate care for trans youth under 18 and also forces schools to "out" students to their parents.



SB 230

Author: Sen. Mizell
Committee: Senate Education
Description: This bill would specifically define who is required to report power-based violence on university campuses and mandate termination for those who must report but fail to do so. It would also require annual reports for power-based violence incidents on campus and provide further compliance measures.



SB 104

Author: Sen. Fesi
Committee: Senate Health & Welfare
Description: This bill would ban clinically appropriate care for trans youth under 18 without parental consent.



SB 232

Description: This bill would create the LA Power-Based Violence Review Board to serve as an advisory board to higher education institutions in issues related to Title IX.
