TRAININGS

- **Consent 101** is a 1-hour workshop to help youth and young adults develop an understanding of consent through dialogue, discussion, and scenarios
- **Sexual Trauma 101** is a 1-hour training through which participants learn about the problem of sexual violence, including types, impacts, causes, and solutions.
- Neurobiology of Trauma is a 1.5-hour training that educates participants about what happens in the brain during a sexual trauma and how this can affect victims' behavior. An abbreviated version is also available for 1 hour.
- Preventing Workplace Harassment: From Compliance to Culture Change is a 1.5-hour training that goes beyond typical compliance-based training approaches and focuses on meaningful strategies to prevent workplace sexual harassment.
